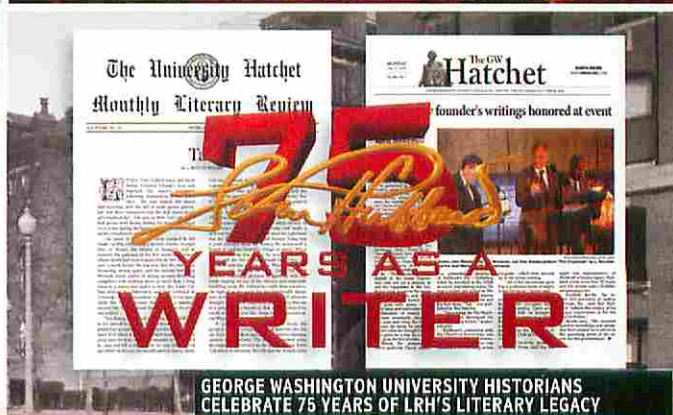
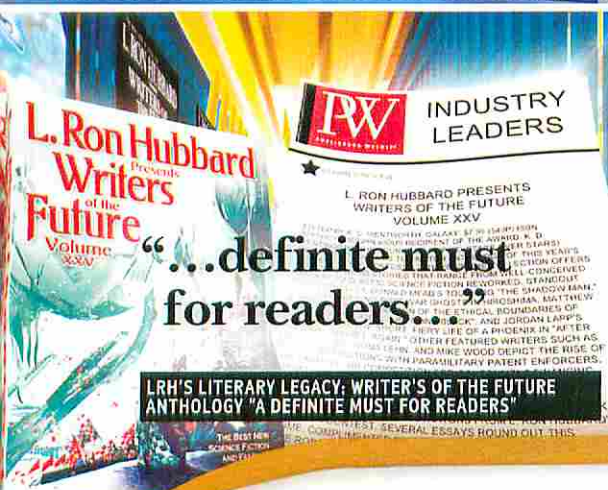
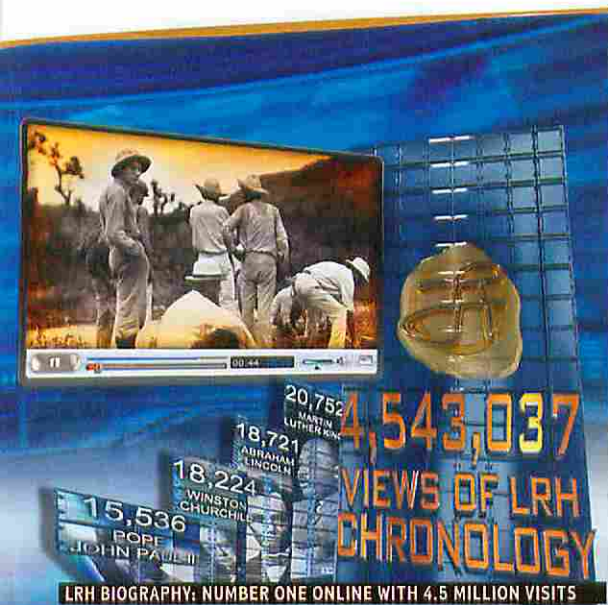
But, of course, no discussion of LRH's

As a matter of fact, there is not an author from the pulp fiction era who still earns the kind of critical kudos bestowed on LRH. While in evidence: Among this year's best audiobooks is an L. Ron Hubbard story from 70 years ago.

So, yes, there is reading LRH, then there is listening to him, and next is *experiencing* LRH: To date and in full, the worldwide impact of LRH as a humanitarian exceeds any other humanitarian effort on Earth. Moreover, his programs extend across every national boundary—Iran, Iraq, even the People's Republic of China. Which, all

told, makes 193 nations on board with his Fourth Dynamic campaigns.

LRH also transcends every political boundary. Just ask Samoa's Prime Minister, the cops in Afghanistan or the President of East Timor. They will all now tell you they know LRH, as will more than 1,800 other government agencies running with his Social Betterment programs.

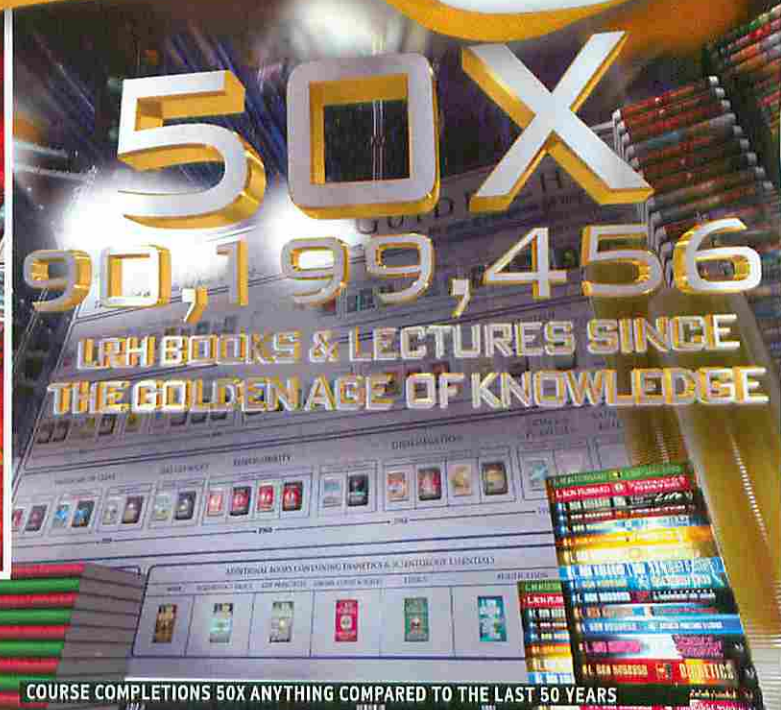
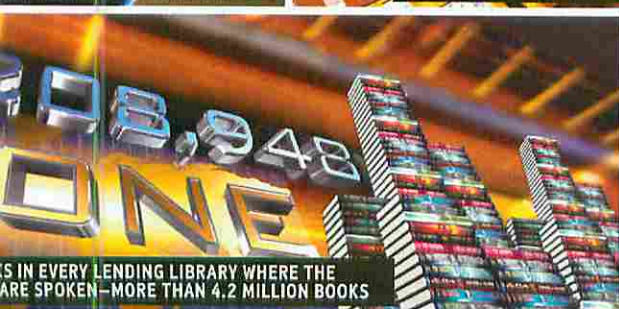

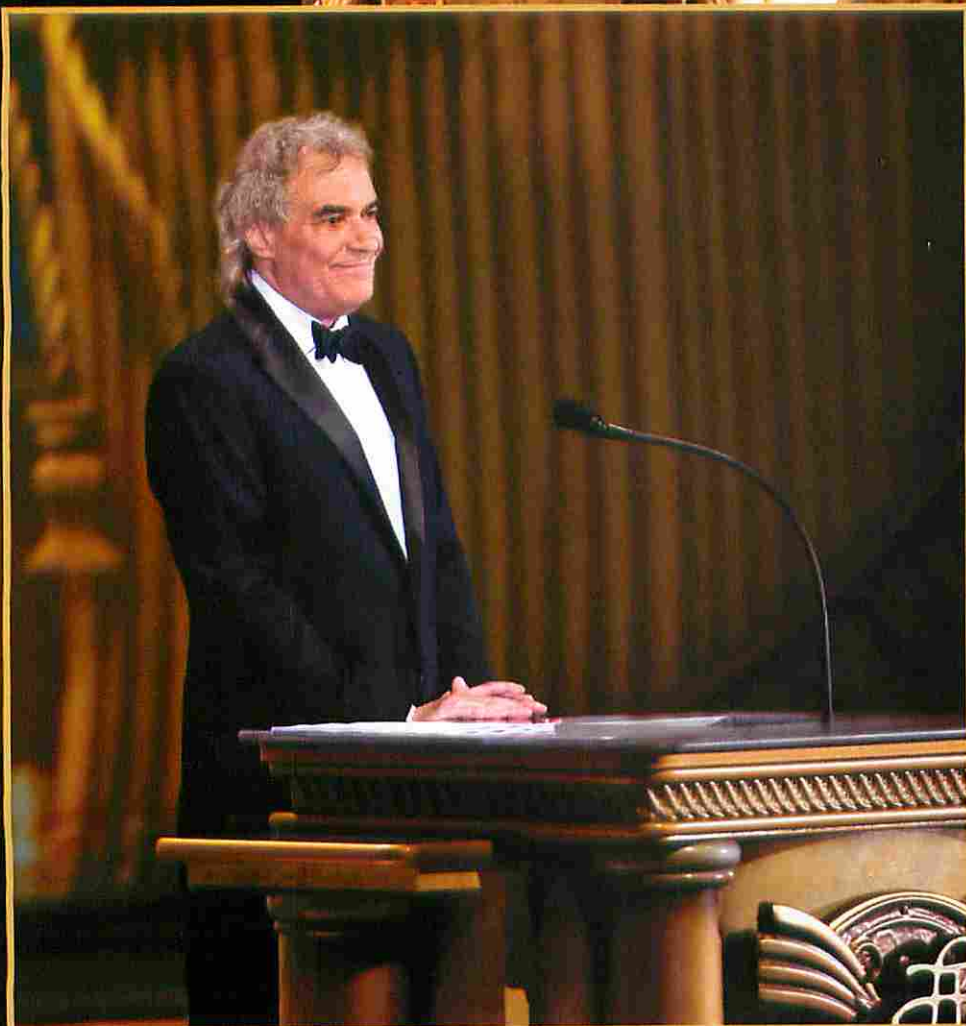

LRH: *The untold story*

Given what LRH most wished for on his birthday, it is traditional on this occasion to tell a tale of how he fueled expansion and drove Scientology Organizations. But as this year saw the release of all LRH materials at the foundation of The Bridge, another tale that can finally be told.

This story runs like an undercurrent through almost every page and passage of the Golden Age of Knowledge materials—beginning with Book One, *Dianetics: The Modern Science of Mental Health*, wherein LRH writes:

“Dianetics addresses war because there is in fact a race between the

science of mind and the atom bomb.”

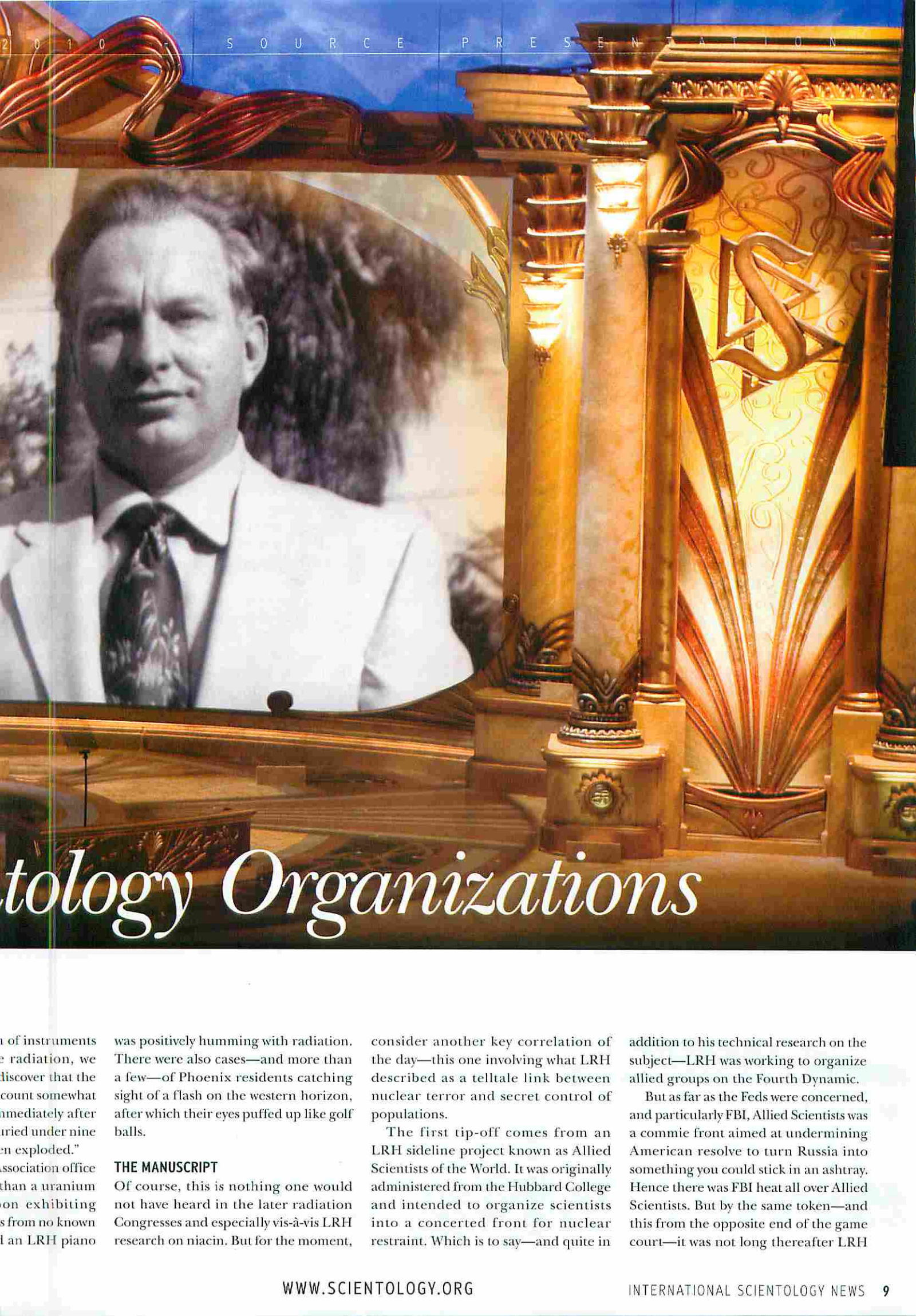
Then again, it is the overriding story behind every LRH technical development thereafter and thus inherent in the better Bridge we know today. So while bits and pieces of this tale have been heard before and the thread winds all through The Basics books and lectures, there is a little known history of Scientology

Organizations, and an altogether secret history of modern civilization. And it all begins like this:

Phoenix, Arizona, 1952: The original Hubbard Association of Scientologists (HAS) then stood at 1405 North Central Avenue, while the bulk of LRH technical research was conducted at a desert laboratory out along Tatum Boulevard

was positively humming with radiation. There were also cases—and more than a few—of Phoenix residents catching sight of a flash on the western horizon, after which their eyes puffed up like golf balls.

THE MANUSCRIPT

Of course, this is nothing one would not have heard in the later radiation Congresses and especially vis-à-vis LRH research on niacin. But for the moment,

consider another key correlation of the day—this one involving what LRH described as a telltale link between nuclear terror and secret control of populations.

The first tip-off comes from an LRH sideline project known as Allied Scientists of the World. It was originally administered from the Hubbard College and intended to organize scientists into a concerted front for nuclear restraint. Which is to say—and quite in

addition to his technical research on the subject—LRH was working to organize allied groups on the Fourth Dynamic.

But as far as the Feds were concerned, and particularly FBI, Allied Scientists was a commie front aimed at undermining American resolve to turn Russia into something you could stick in an ashtray. Hence there was FBI heat all over Allied Scientists. But by the same token—and this from the opposite end of the game court—it was not long thereafter LRH

So that was Phoenix circa 1955: broad public dissemination through a veritable briar patch of American conservatism, a fully codified auditor training regimen and, of course, the whole religious framework of Scientology.

like an incandescent bulb with another nuclear flash from Nevada. LRH himself makes mention of it through his *Golden Dawn* lecture on the 9th of March, and it's a recurrent theme throughout. As a matter of fact, his opening talk in the series, "The Wrong Thing to Do Is Nothing," repeatedly touches

license plates—presumably because anyone outside Arizona was probably commie inasmuch as Republican Senator Barry Goldwater hailed from Arizona and he is the one who all but coined that phrase "better dead than Red."

But by the same token—and this also from May 1955—unnamed sources within

The implication being: an open channel cuts both ways, and so came the first tenuous feelers from a Secretary of Defense who finally woke up to the fact that Scientology might just be the antidote to commie brainwashing techniques which were now at work in North Korean POW camps.

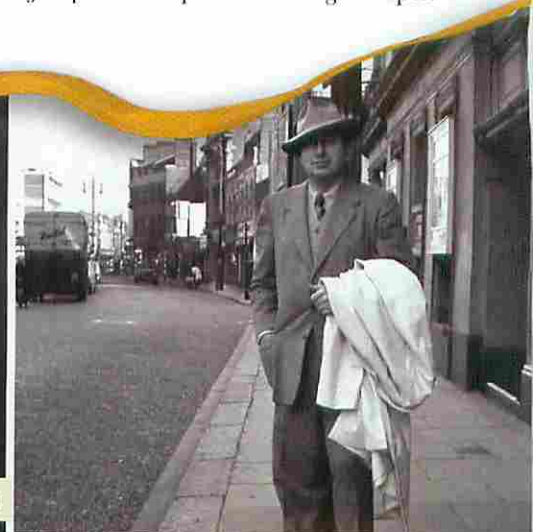
All of which explains Phoenix expansion across eight separate facilities to accommodate the throngs of Scientologists from all across America. But now juxtapose dissemination and auditor training against that ever-ticking "doomsday clock," and we come to a sequence that plays out as follows:

At 6:20 A.M. on the 7th of March 1955, the Phoenix skyline once again lights up

on what an ever-present nuclear threat spells in terms of mass apathy.

...it was Tom Esterbrook who frequently gave voice to LRH social commentary—this one, for example, concerning government censorship in the name of national security: “Freedom is a shifty thing when rulers make it so.”

Which is to say, Esterbrook was an LRH *nom de plume* and particularly employed whenever he wished to flex his literary muscle. By way of example, it was Esterbrook who told of an all-hands effort to write, print and post a *Journal of Scientology* in a single night through January 1955, of which he wrote:

"You got it at all because Ron, after his Wednesday public lecture that happens every Wednesday night here, came

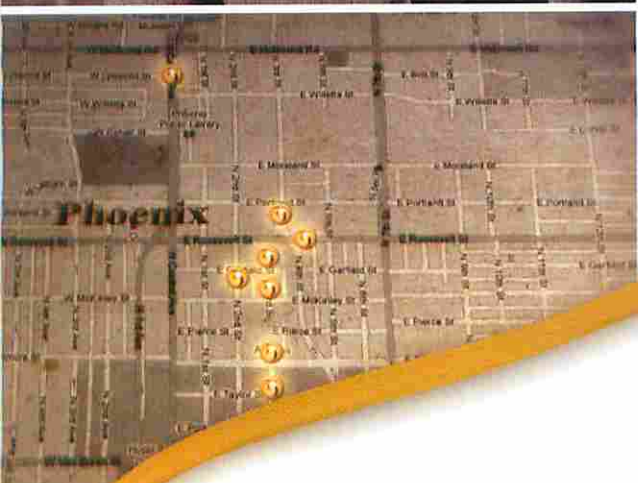

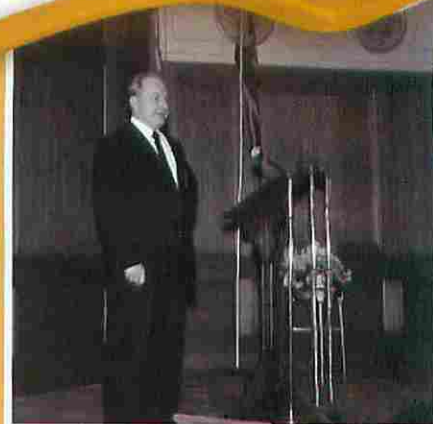

Catering to an international Scientology movement on both sides of the Atlantic, LRH totalled up some 35,000 travel miles between the US and Great Britain to provide lectures, instruction and administration.



The Founding Church, Washington, DC marked an historic advance. But less visible were clues to national guidance via President Eisenhower, and more distant Scientology feats: official relief to Hungarian refugees, salvaging a highly-placed Cuban cripple and processing the 661st Anacostia Flight Squadron to their safest year in history.

"The answers to such problems as the atomic bomb lie in the problem of communication."

So while thus far tracing the birth of a first Central Organization for Europe, the time had now come for a first Central Organization even vaguely capable of opening channels to American society—an organization from which to advance broad-scale

discoveries to far more than just professional students: the Founding Church in Washington, DC.

EVENTS IN WASHINGTON

As an overarching word, what follows is directly consequent to what just preceded. Which is to say: an organizational structure and administrative pattern to open channels into all sorts of interesting nooks and crannies. So, albeit in brief—and quite in addition to Congresses, Clinical Courses, HGC and Academy supervision—this is how LRH patterned Scientology for use across the whole social pale.

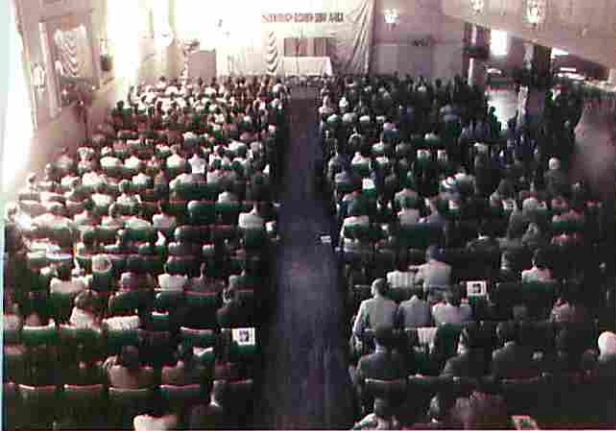
November 1956: LRH receives a cablegram from an American Society of Disaster Relief concerning 30,000

refugees from the ill-fated Hungarian Revolution of October 1956. It is still remembered as a defining moment in Cold War history and everyone wanted a piece of the action. But when said refugees landed at the Camp Kilmer receiving station in Piscataway, New Jersey, CIA evaluators pretty much bolted the doors.

Yet what was described as the "therapeutic agency" with respect to refugee mental health, and thus the only authorized treatment for emotional problems—that was a Scientology Assist and Group Auditing program.

There was more again from London, this one concerning an LRH auditing program for Britain's Pentathlon Team. The lads were then in training at Aldershot. The only medal hopeful had just fractured

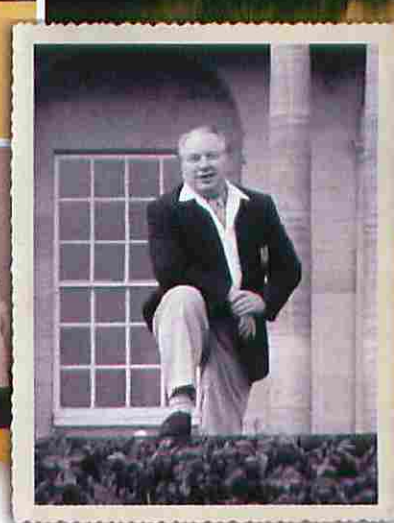


Further Scientology strongholds arose as LRH established Hubbard Associations of Scientologists in South Africa (above left and above) and Australia (below).

an arm, and not a bookmaker in Britain entertained any hope the team would rise from its customary rating, which was dead last. But sure enough, come the '56 Olympic Games in Melbourne, an Objectives preclar does the 3,000-meter steeplechase in 8 minutes 41 seconds to take the Gold against astonishing odds.

Then there was the late 1956-57 program on behalf of airborne combat units. In this case, LRH was directing a naval flight surgeon to run Reach and Withdraw on the 661st Anacostia Flight Squadron, thereby reducing pilot reaction time to upwards of one-sixtieth of a second. After which commanders reported not a single in-flight mishap and the year went down as the safest in Naval Aviation History.

There was still more from the political arena and this one was especially hot, because this was about Castro's Cuba, which was then tantamount to antimatter. The details are these:

In late 1958, with Castro poised outside Havana, LRH spends a night on a telephone with an auditor tending to the wife of an old-line Cuban general. While the auditor's name goes unmentioned, he is almost certainly the same one who soon after processed one Coton

Bustamante—*Doctor Bustamante* to be perfectly proper—and a fairly significant footnote in history as personal physician to Fidel Castro. All of which becomes even more significant for the fact Bustamante had been wheelchair-bound with a neuropathic disorder. But after less than fifty hours of auditing, up he goes and walks four blocks for the first

LRH had glimpsed the shape of things to come—or at least a distinct possibility. But he was also now looking at other possibilities, and he literally worked the problem mathematically: a few hundred auditors versus a worldwide population then at about 2.5 billion and every one of them requiring about 500 professional hours.

At which point this story goes positively incendiary. LRH himself describes it as a "hot potato," and he is coolly understating it. Because Bustamante is next writing to inform all concerned of his Scientology discussions with "my friend and companion, Fidel Castro."

THE GREATER VIEW

It is the whole geopolitical panorama that reveals the next destination, and this one is especially vast.

Because this one begins with a letter to then President Dwight D. Eisenhower—a letter wherein LRH advises Ike to spread his military targets so far and wide the

from Central Org to Central Org, he was looking at a *single* emanation point from which to cope with all Scientology concerns. He was also looking at 55 acres of gardens and downs at Saint Hill Manor in the United Kingdom, replete with numerous potential course rooms and a tennis court for co-audits. All of which, in turn, is to say: "This is the luxury estate of the Maharajah of Jaipur, and is the present home of HCO Worldwide."

That was the turning point in Scientology history from whence came the technical and organizational standards for World Clearing.

THE SHAPE OF SAINT HILL

Saint Hill was a model for all subsequent Organizations and the catalyst for global expansion—a statement that tells volumes on the thrust and shape of Scientology today, and a statement that tells a lot about LRH, even when one lays it out in shorthand like he does here:

"In January 1963, I took measure of how much time we had before any axe fell."

He then goes on to explain that, based on all global indicators, it was imperative he complete the basic technology of Clearing and OT by March 1964. Which is exactly how it played and which inevitably led to both the Grade Chart and Seven Division Org Board one year later. But through the process it also led to this:

On the 7th of March 1965, through the thick of that research, LRH writes of a contest to get organized as the only

means of "halting the big BANG." To which he adds:

"Puny us, just now. A Scientology David and a Hydrogen Goliath. But we aren't using just a slingshot, lucky as it was in David's hand. We're using the technology for which Man even in his cruelty and his blindness searched for cons. And we must get it out and use it."

Whereupon, one week later on the 15th of March, it was completion of the Power Processes. And so it went: the 25th of March with Saint Hill's HGC commencing delivery of those processes, the 15th of July with commencement of R6EW *Solo* auditing amongst Saint Hill students, the 3rd of September with the first enrollment on the Clearing Course, and the 9th of September with the codification of all levels of Release and the unveiling of the first Classification and Gradation Chart.

So yes, the technical advance of 1965 opened the door to World Clearing. But for all that, it was an advance on another front for which LRH named this year. To wit: 1965 was "The Year of Organization."

In fact, it is the sum and substance of everything we celebrate at LRH's Birthday Celebration. Because that was LRH's development of a Seven Division Org Board that harnessed the power of his technology to audit the planet itself. So take a good hard look at those Seven Divisions—and there it is. For when we as Scientologists move across that Org Board, mirroring our ascent up The Bridge, we inevitably arrive at the final department—and *there* are the New Civilization activities: Gung-Ho Groups,

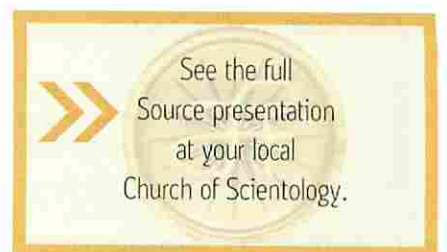
OT Committees, Social Betterment Activities, Special Zone Projects.

Then again, as LRH tells us, the whole Organization moves in cycles—first, a full and long Organizational Cycle, after which comes a Qualifications Cycle in which we adjust *Civilization*. And yes, all of it is intrinsic to the makeup of our Organizations.

Because just as LRH plumbed the bottom of individual cases, so he plumbed the bottom of the planetary case. And just as he patterned our Organizations for First Dynamic auditing, so they are patterned for Fourth Dynamic auditing.

And beyond that, Scientology Organizations were his big game pieces for the planetary board and the *only* thing that would keep the bombs at bay and "shades of night" from falling on this world.

After which this story becomes a *never-ending* story—and what LRH described as a history "written out loud"—a history that tells of a Scientology movement thriving on every continent and welcoming millions across a great and sturdy Bridge, a history more victorious with each new day, and a history that meets the future with something we now build for eternity: Scientology Ideal Organizations.

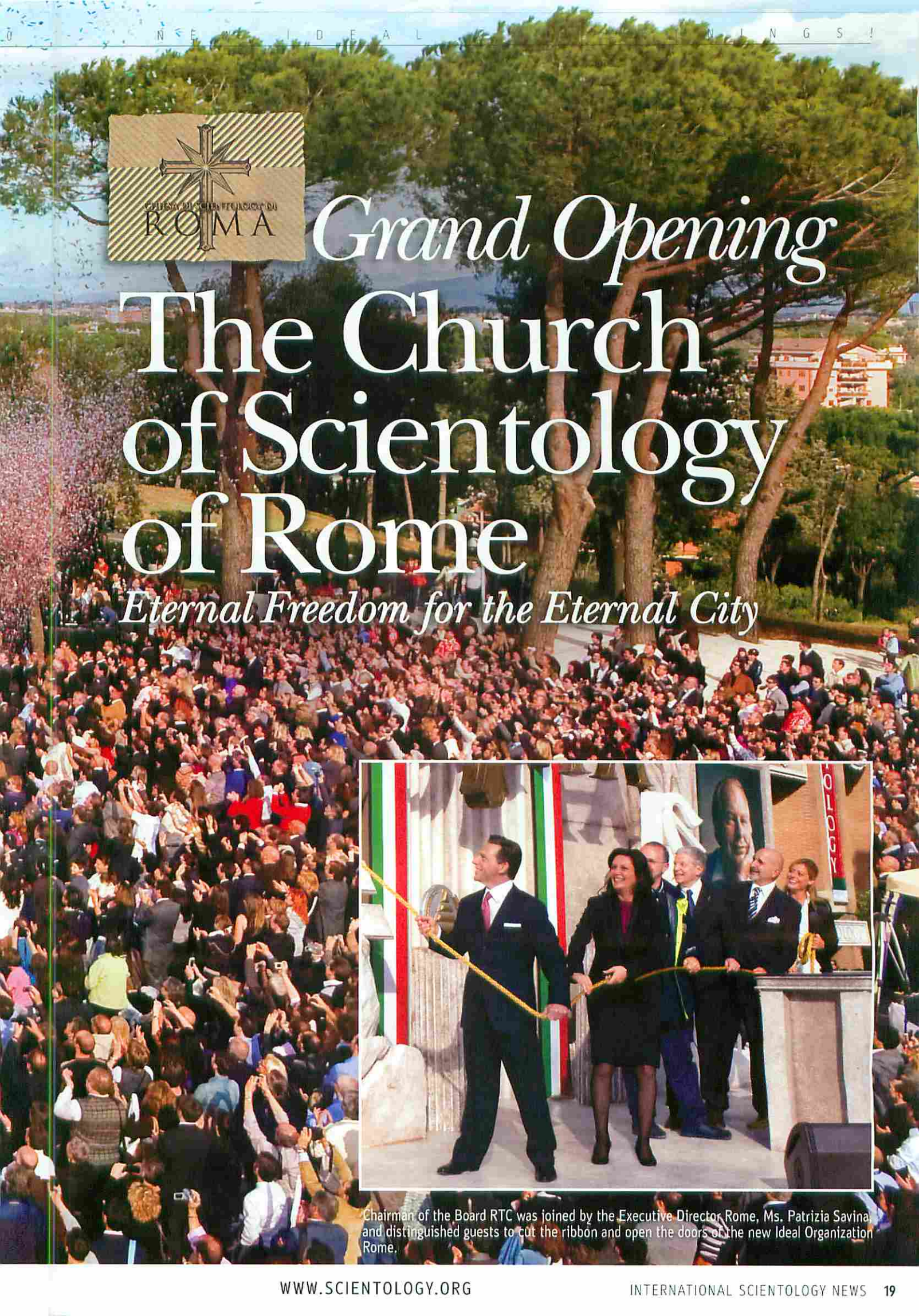

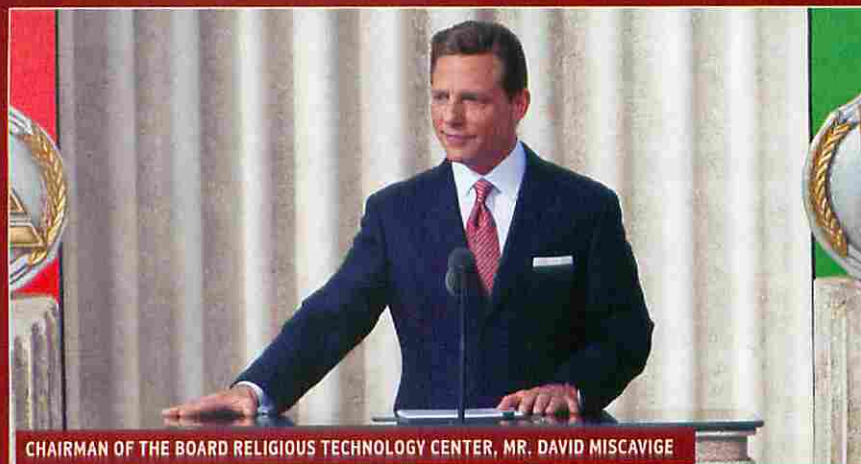

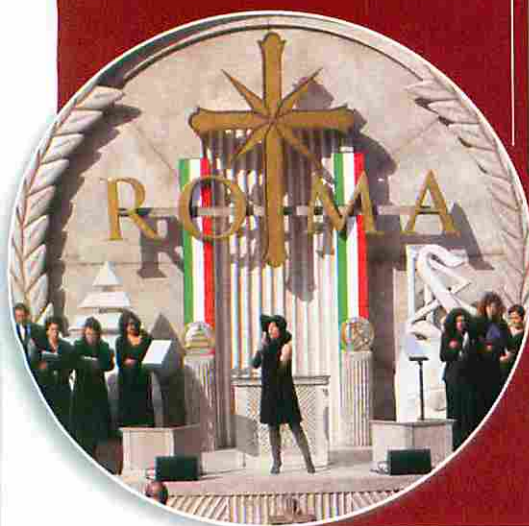

On October 24, 2009, amidst the warmth and spirit of 6,000 Italian Scientologists from up and down the Italian boot, joined by visitors from across Europe, America and as far as the Middle East, a new Church of Scientology opened its doors in a place that has been at the center of the Western World for at least a thousand years. Designated as both the "Eternal City" and the "City of God," it is now home to the Church of Scientology of Rome.

Situated immediately outside the old city, five miles from the Vatican, the 70,000 square-foot building stands on 28 acres along the Casalotti hills. Its contemporary architecture is a modern

interpretation of the Roman arch.

That it was originally built as a monastery is no insignificant matter. For while every inch of it is an Ideal Org—with a Public Information Center that is perfectly aligned with LRH policy—this is also a Church that speaks with just the right intonation to those who live in a city where religion rules.

This is also an Org that says: "maybe the Roman Empire never really died. Maybe it just hunkered down until something like *this* came along." While it has often been said that an Ideal Org is far more than the sum of its physical parts, the Church of Scientology of Rome is living proof.

In addition to physical structure, building an Ideal Org includes recruitment and training of its staff. In the case of Rome, this amounts to a 19-man Hubbard Communications Office, 31 more in the Public Divisions and a technical complement 62 strong—24 of them Flag-trained. Altogether, Rome now counts 165 staff, and all for the new Italian Renaissance.

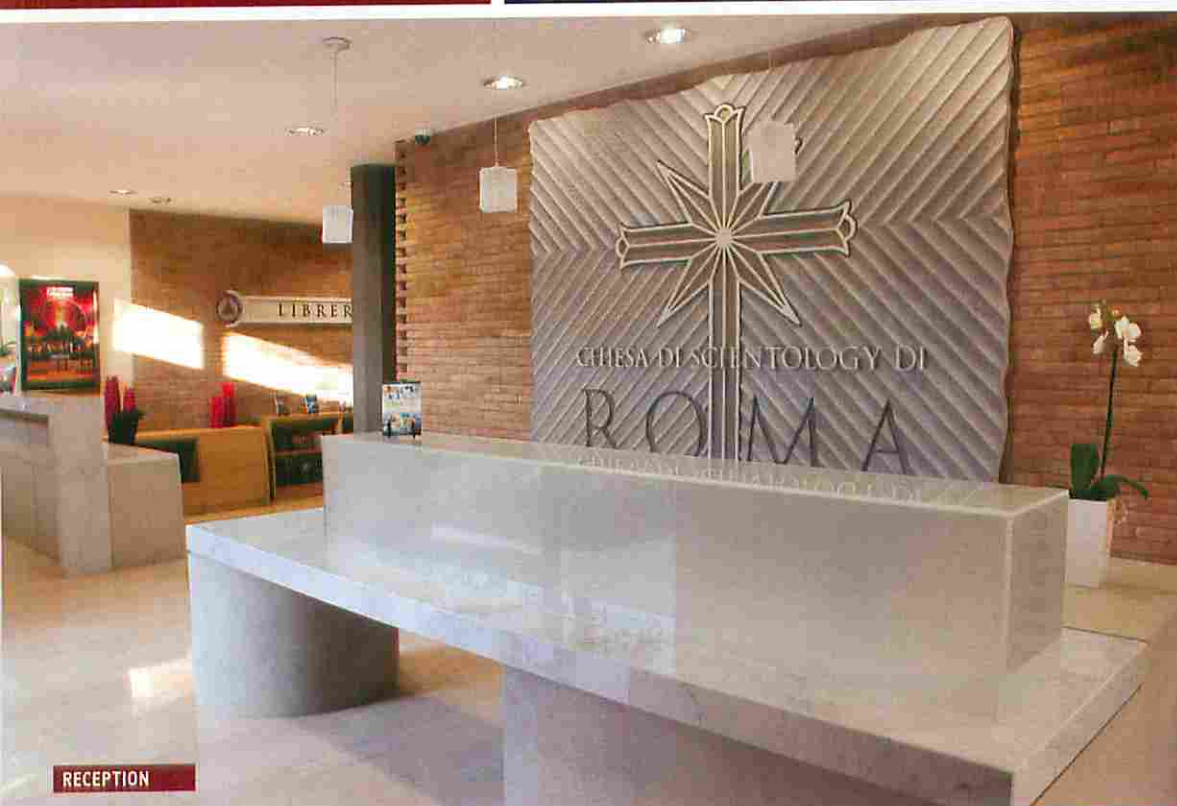

October 31, 2009 marked the official grand opening celebration of an Org originally built by LRH—one capable of "changing the course of human events"—the new Founding Church of Scientology of Washington, DC.

Needless to say, Washington, DC, is nothing if not historically significant. Meaning: this is where American history and Scientology history intersects. This is also where there was really no choice but to build an Ideal Org—if only because Scientology is a religion that was "born in the USA."

The specifics are as follows: It stands at 1424 16th Street Northwest, otherwise known as Embassy Row in the Dupont Circle neighborhood. While to place it

The fact that it is a genuine landmark makes it all the more politically correct. On the 20th of January 2010, Scientologists and guests from across Canada and the United States gathered in Québec City for the official opening ceremony of the new Ideal Org of Québec.

Québec itself is a place travel agencies used to call the best kept secret in Canada. And it is still not quite “of this world”—except for the fact it is the source-point for a lot of what defines cutting edge today. As a matter of fact, it is the hidden hand behind everything from avant-garde design to Cirque du Soleil.

It is the old Québécois heartland and the oldest surviving settlement in North America. It is also where French Canada was orphaned—meaning, where the

British grabbed the colony. Or as the Québécois themselves will tell you: They were born under a French fleur-de-lis but raised beneath an English rose.

The new Québec Church stands below the Old Town at 665 rue St-Joseph. It's right in the heart of the walking district where better than 1,500 Québécois pass every hour and where the Public Division is front and center to provide an Ideal Org *bienvenue*.

Considering Québec is arguably one of the most enchanting cities in the world, this Ideal Org does not disappoint. It is a perfect blend of Art Deco detailing, rustic elements and the famed Québécois mix of old and new.

The building bisects two main

thoroughfares, so there's a second entrance on Boulevard Charest—the threshold that leads to Québec's Field Activities lounge, from where they coordinate a province-wide drive to advance LRH social salvage solutions.

To take Québécois to spiritual freedom, a Flag-trained Senior Case Supervisor and auditing team man a full wing of auditing rooms, each perfectly appointed per Ideal Org standards and Québécois style. And, what powers this Org are its staff—five of them OT—and 108 in all.

All vectors were aligned for exponential expansion across entire geographic zones, which is how the Continental Liaison Offices kept their thoroughbreds on track. And here are the results:

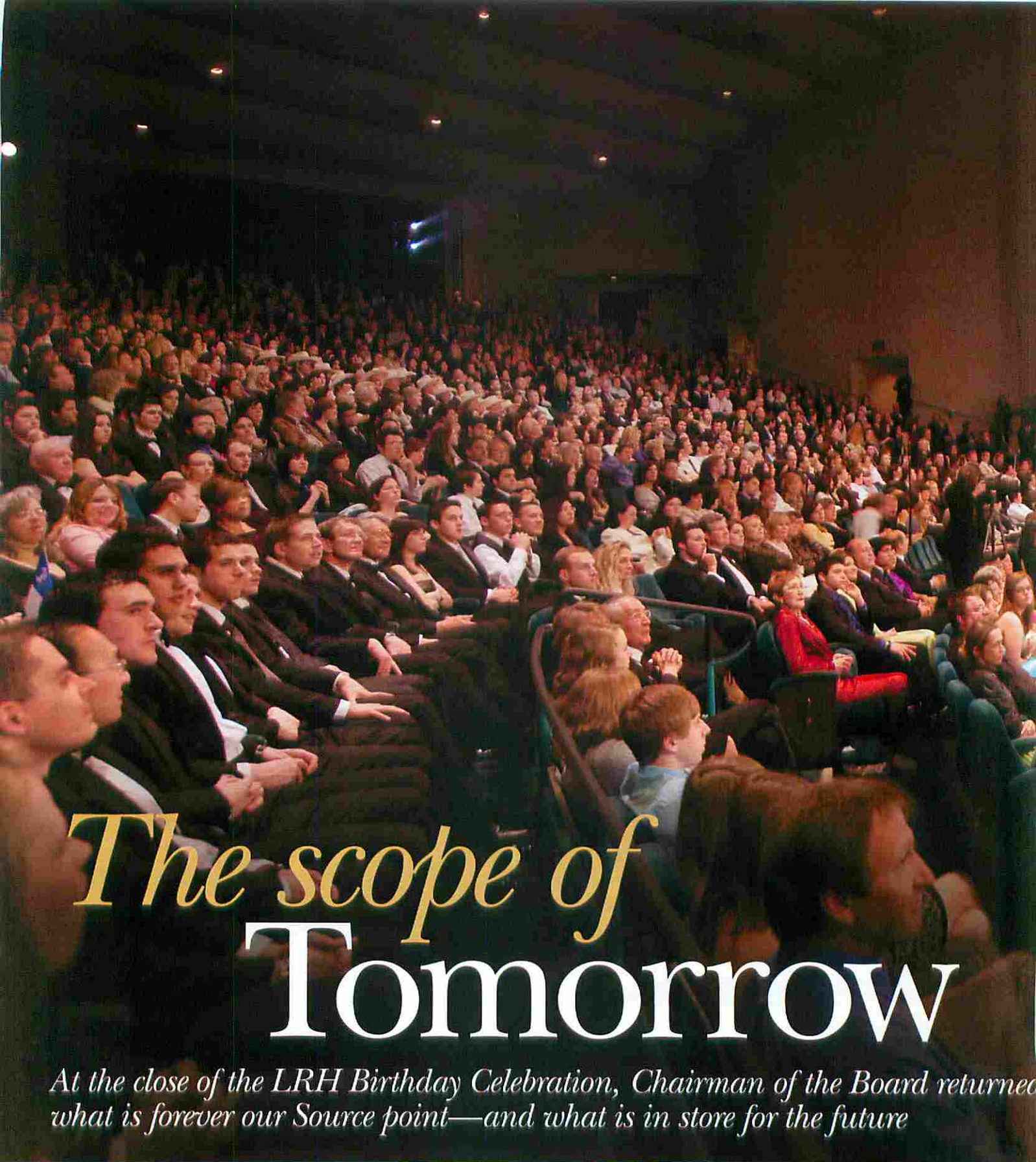

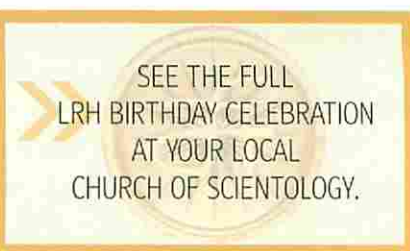

Every Ideal Org is a road to freedom—and all roads lead to Flag

If you haven't been to Flag recently, or if you've never been, even the most colorful description can hardly prepare you for what awaits. Quite aside from physically doubling in size with the opening of the Oak Cove and rededication of the Fort Harrison, Flag is now delivering auditing and training in a volume that can only be described in terms of "correct orders of magnitude." In point of fact, some 2,500 students and preclears move through Flag training and processing services every week.

FLAG'S HGCs

At the Oak Cove, Flag's delivery team is taking another Scientologist through the Scientology Lower Grades, NED, or special Flag-only and L Rundowns at a rate of every two hours, each and every day. Of course, it all goes hand in hand with technical perfection, so the result is immense volume of auditing at astonishing speed. As but one example, an average of two-and-a-half months from Life Repair to Clear is not uncommon.

At the same time, the Flag Advanced Org welcomes another pre-OT to their next OT level every four and one-half hours.
