## King Lear



Cornwall is very angry with Gloucester because Edmund has shown him a letter proving that Gloucester is a spy. Edmund pretends to be surprised about his father's guilt, but he's happy because Cornwall makes him the earl of Gloucester.

كورنوال غضب جداً من جلوستر لأن إدموند أظهر له رسالة تثبت أن جلوستر جاسوس. ويتظاهر "إدموند" بأنه متفاجئ من ذنب والده، لكنه سعيد لأن كورنوال جعله إيرل جلوستر.

Gloucester tells Kent about a plan to get rid of the king. He asks Kent and take Lear to Dover, where friends are ready to help. They, along with the Fool, leave.

جلوستر يخبر كينت عن خطة للتخلص من الملك. يطلب من كينت أن يأخذ لير إلى دوفر، حيث يكون الأصدقاء على استعداد للمساعدة. ويغادرون مع المهرج.

Cornwall gives Goneril a letter about the French army at Dover and tells her to show it to her husband, Albany. He then sends his servants to arrest Gloucester to be punished. He orders Edmund to go with Goneril to Albany's palace so that Edmund will not have to see his father's punishment.

كورنوال يعطي جونيريل رسالة عن الجيش الفرنسي في دوفر ويطلب منها أن تريها لزوجها ألباني. ثم يرسل خدمه للقبض على جلوستر لمعاقبته. يأمر إدموند بالذهاب مع جونيريل إلى قصر ألباني حتى لا يضطر إدموند إلى رؤية عقوبة والده.

Oswald tells Cornwall that Gloucester has helped Lear escape to Dover. Gloucester is found and brought before Regan and Cornwall. They treat him cruelly. Cornwall cannot kill Gloucester without a trial but he can punish him severely.

أخبر أوزوالد كورنوال أن جلوستر ساعد لير على الهروب إلى دوفر. تم العثور على جلوستر وإحضاره أمام ريجان وكورنوال. فيعاملانه بقسوة. كورنوال لا يستطيع قتل جلوستر بدون محاكمة ولكن بإمكانه معاقبته بشدة.

Gloucester's servant tries to stop Cornwall attacking Gloucester. Cornwall takes out his sword, and they start fighting. The servant hurts Cornwall, but Regan takes another sword and kills the servant before he can hurt Cornwall more.

يحاول خادم جلوستر منع كورنوال من مهاجمة جلوستر. أخرج كورنوال سيفه وبدأوا القتال. يُصيب الخادم كورنوال، لكن ريجان تأخذ سيفاً آخر وتقتل الخادم قبل أن يتمكن من إحداث مزيد من الإصابات لـ "كورنوال".

Gloucester asks Edmund for help, but Regan says Edmund betrayed him. Gloucester realizes he misunderstood and that his other son, Edgar, truly loves him. Regan orders Gloucester to be thrown out of the palace.

يطلب جلوستر المساعدة من إدموند، لكن ريجان تقول إن إدموند خانته. فيدرك جلوستر أنه أساء الفهم وأن ابنه الآخر إدجار يحبه حقاً. تأمر ريجان بطرد جلوستر من القصر.

Gloucester is bleeding when he meets his son, Edgar, who is pretending to be a mad beggar. He wishes he could touch his son Edgar again. Edgar wishes he didn't have to pretend to be a beggar. However, he decides to stay disguised as Poor Tom. ينزف جلوستر عندما يلتقي بابنه الذي يتظاهر بأنه متسول مجنون. ويتمنى أن يتمكن من لمس ابنه إدجار مرة أخرى. ويتمنى إدجار ألا يضطر إلى التظاهر بأنه متسول. ومع ذلك، قرر البقاء متنكرًا بزي توم المسكين.

Goneril says Albany is not brave and decides to control his soldiers herself. She tells Edmund to get Cornwall's soldiers ready to fight the French. She also plans to take power from her husband. جونيрил تقول أن ألباني ليس شجاعاً وتقرر السيطرة على جنوده بنفسها. فتطلب من إدموند تجهيز جنود كورنوال لمحاربة الفرنسيين. كما تخطط لتولي السلطة من زوجها.

Albany tells Goneril that she is evil and that he's starting to feel frightened of her. He also says that Goneril and her sister are like tigers. He gets angry when he hears that Goneril and Regan treated King Lear so badly that he went mad. Goneril gets angry and insults Albany, saying he's a coward. She tells him he should be getting ready to fight against the French army. ألباني يخبر جونيрил أنها شريرة وأنه بدأ يشعر بالخوف منها. كما يقول أن جونيрил وشقيقتها مثل النمور. إنه يشعر بالغضب عندما يسمع أن جونيрил وريجان عاملوا الملك لير بشكل سيء للغاية لدرجة أنه أصيب بالجنون. فتغضب جونيрил وتهين ألباني قائلة أنه جبان. كما أخبرته أنه يجب أن يستعد للقتال ضد الجيش الفرنسي.

Cornwall dies because of the injury he has got while hurting Gloucester's eyes. Albany is shocked when he hears about Gloucester being blinded. Goneril has mixed feelings about Cornwall's death – it makes her sister Regan less powerful, but now Regan can be with Edmund. يموت كورنوال بسبب الإصابة التي أصيب بها أثناء إصابة عيون جلوستر. ويشعر ألباني بالصدمة عندما يسمع عن إصابة جلوستر بالعمى. تشعر جونيрил بمشاعر متضاربة بشأن وفاة كورنوال – فهي تجعل أختها ريجان أقل قوة، ولكن الآن يمكن أن تكون ريجان مع إدموند.

Albany finds out that Gloucester was attacked and promises to take revenge because Gloucester was hurt. He hears that it was Edmund who betrayed Gloucester and that Edmund left the house so that Cornwall could punish Gloucester. يكتشف ألباني أن جلوستر تعرض للهجوم فوعد بالانتقام لأن جلوستر أصيب. ويسمع أن إدموند هو الذي خان جلوستر وأن إدموند غادر المنزل حتى يتمكن كورنوال من معاقبة جلوستر.

Kent tells the gentleman that Lear refuses to see Cordelia because of the way he treated her. The gentleman tells Kent that the armies of Albany and Cornwall are ready to fight against the French army. يخبر كينت الرجل المحترم أن لير يرفض رؤية كورديليا بسبب الطريقة التي عاملها بها. يخبر الرجل كينت أن جيوش ألباني وكورنوال مستعدة للقتال ضد الجيش الفرنسي.

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Edgar leads Gloucester toward Dover. Edgar pretends to take Gloucester to the cliff, telling him that they are going up steep ground and that they can hear the sea. Finally, he tells Gloucester that they are at the top of the cliff. He asks Edgar to let go of his hand. He gives him a purse that contains a valuable jewel.

يقود إدجار جلوستر نحو دوفر. يتظاهر إدجار بأخذ جلوستر إلى المنحدر، ويخبره أنهم يصعدون إلى أرض شديدة الانحدار وأنهم يستطيعون سماع صوت البحر. أخيراً، أخبر جلوستر أنهم على قمة المنحدر. يطلب من إدجار أن يترك يده. وأعطاه حقيبة تحتوي على جوهرة ثمينة.

Edgar waits quietly nearby. Gloucester can't stand his suffering and wants to kill himself. He falls to the ground.

ينتظر إدجار بهدوء في مكان قريب. لا يستطيع جلوستر تحمل معاناته ويريد أن يقتل نفسه. يسقط جلوستر على الأرض.

Edgar wakes Gloucester up. He no longer pretends to be Poor Tom. Edgar says that he saw him fall from the top of a high cliff and that it is amazing that he is still alive.

إدجار يوقظ جلوستر. لم يعد يتظاهر بأنه توم المسكين. يقول إدجار إنه رأى يسقط من أعلى منحدر مرتفع، ومن المدهش أنه لا يزال على قيد الحياة.

King Lear says that Goneril and Regan pretended to be kind to him and told him how wise he was, but he learnt the truth. They are not women who he can trust! They told him he was everything to them, but it was a lie.

يقول الملك لير إن جونيрил وريجان تظاهرتا بالعطف عليه وأخبرتاه بمدى حكمته، لكنه عرف الحقيقة. إنهن لسن نساء يمكن أن يثق بهن! أخبروه أنه كان كل شيء بالنسبة لهم، لكنها كانت كذبة.

Lear meets Gloucester but doesn't recognize him because he can't see. Lear asks him to read a letter, even though he is blind. He accuses him of wanting money before reading the letter. Gloucester says that he feels his way, and Lear says that a judge will punish a poor man's crime before a rich man's crime. Edgar notices that Lear is talking both sense and nonsense.

يلتقي لير بجلوستر لكنه لا يتعرف عليه لأنه لا يستطيع الرؤية. يطلب منه لير أن يقرأ رسالة، رغم أنه أعمى. ويتهمه بأنه يريد المال قبل قراءة الرسالة. يقول جلوستر إنه يتحسس طريقه، ويقول لير إن القاضي سيعاقب علي جريمة الرجل الفقير قبل جريمة الرجل الغني. لاحظ إدجار أن لير يقول كلاماً معقولاً وفي نفس الوقت يهذي

Oswald wants to kill Gloucester for a reward. Edgar defends Gloucester and kills Oswald. As he dies, Oswald asks Edgar to deliver letters to Edmund, showing Goneril's plan to kill her husband, Albany. Edgar decides to show it to Albany.

يريد أوزوالد قتل جلوستر من أجل الحصول على مكافأة. إدجار يدافع عن جلوستر ويقتل أوزوالد. عندما يموت، يطلب أوزوالد من إدجار تسليم رسائل إلى إدموند، توضح خطة جونيрил لقتل زوجها ألباني. فيقرر إدجار إي ذلك لألباني.

Cordelia is concerned about her father, King Lear, who is sleeping and has become like a child.

كورديليا تشعر بالقلق على والدها الملك لير النائم والذي أصبح كالطفل.

King Lear is brought into the tent while sleeping, and Cordelia tries to comfort him with kisses, expressing sorrow for his mistreatment by her sisters.

يتم إحضار الملك لير إلى الخيمة أثناء نومه ، وتحاول كورديليا مواساته بالقبلات ، معبرة عن حزنها لسوء معاملة أختيها له .

King Lear wakes up and feels like he's on a "wheel of fire."

يستيقظ الملك لير ويشعر وكأنه على "عجلة من نار".

Cordelia expresses her love, while Lear apologizes for his foolishness and asks for forgiveness.

كورديليا تعبر عن حبها ، و لير يعتذر عن حماقته ويطلب المغفرة .

The doctor suggests leaving Lear to rest, and Lear asks for Cordelia's forgiveness, feeling old and foolish.

يقترح الطبيب ترك لير ليرتاح ، ويطلب لير مغفرة كورديليا ، لأنه يشعر بالشيخوخة والحماقة .

Regan asks Edmund if he is working for Goneril or helping her to take her lands from her. Edmund says he is not.

تسأل ريجان إدموند عما إذا كان يعمل لدى جونيрил أو يساعدها في أخذ أراضيها منها . يقول إدموند أنه ليس كذلك .

Albany says that he has heard that the French army has been joined by Lear, Cordelia and others. Albany says that he intends to fight with Edmund, Regan, and Goneril against the foreign invasion. Goneril wants Edmund to be on her side and Regan wants the same thing.

يقول ألباني إنه سمع أن الجيش الفرنسي قد انضم إليه لير وكورديليا وآخرون . يقول ألباني إنه ينوي القتال مع إدموند وريجان وجونيрил ضد الغزو الأجنبي . تريد جونيрил أن يكون إدموند إلى جانبها وتريد ريجان نفس الشيء .

Edgar, disguised as Poor Tom, gives Albany the letter that he took from Oswald's body—the letter in which Goneril asks Edmund to kill Albany.

إدجار ، متنكرًا بزي توم المسكين ، يعطي ألباني الرسالة التي أخذها من جسد أوزوالد - الرسالة التي يطلب فيها جونيрил من إدموند قتل ألباني .

Edmund says that he has told Regan and Goneril that he'll help them to win more power. He wonders what he should do. He decides to put off the decision until after the battle. He says that if the British win the battle and he captures Lear and Cordelia, he will put them in prison.

يقول إدموند إنه أخبر ريجان وجونيрил أنه سيساعدهما على الفوز بمزيد من السلطة . يتساءل ماذا يجب أن يفعل . قرر تأجيل القرار إلى ما بعد المعركة . يقول إنه إذا انتصر البريطانيون في المعركة وأسّر لير وكورديليا ، فسوف يضعهم في السجن .

Gloucester says that he will stay where he is and wait to be arrested or killed, but Edgar says that no one can choose the time of their death or the time of their birth.

يصرح جلوستر أنه سيبقى حيث هو وينتظر أن يتم القبض عليه أو قتله ، لكن إدجار يقول أنه لا يمكن لأحد أن يختار وقت وفاته أو وقت ولادته .

Edmund takes Lear and Cordelia as prisoners. Cordelia feels sad for the king who has suffered much. Lear refuses to see Regan and Goneril and prefers to go to prison with his daughter Cordelia. Edmund sends them away, giving the captain a message with orders as to what to do with them.

يتخذ إدموند لير وكورديليا كاسرى. تشعر كورديليا بالحزن على الملك الذي عانى كثيراً. يرفض لير رؤية ريغان وجونيريل ويفضل الذهاب إلى السجن حيث يعيش هو وكورديليا بمفردهما مثل الطيور في قفص. يرسلهم إدموند بعيداً، ويعطي القبطان رسالة تحتوي على أوامر حول ما يجب فعله بهم.

Albany praises Edmund for being brave in the battle and asks to see Lear and Cordelia. Edmund says he sent Lear to prison because he thinks if the soldiers see him, they will feel sorry for him because he's old. Albany tells Edmund he is a good soldier but not his equal. Goneril accuses Regan of planning to take power and land with the help of Edmund.

يشيد ألباني بإدموند لشجاعته في المعركة ويطلب رؤية لير وكورديليا. يقول إدموند إنه أرسل لير إلى السجن لأنه يعتقد أن الجنود إذا رأوه سيشعرون بالأسف عليه لأنه كبير في السن. أخبر ألباني إدموند أنه جندي جيد ولكنه ليس مساوياً له. تتهم جونيريل ريغان بالتخطيط للاستيلاء على السلطة والأرض بمساعدة إدموند.

Albany arrests Edmund for treason. Edgar appears to accuse Edmund of treason and face him in a fight. Edgar defeats Edmund. Goneril tries to help the wounded Edmund, but Albany brings out her letter to Edmund to show that he knows of her plot against him.

ألباني يعتقل إدموند بتهمة الخيانة. يظهر إدجار لیتهم إدموند بالخيانة ويواجهه في معركة. إدجار يهزم إدموند. تحاول جونيريل مساعدة إدموند الجريح، لكن ألباني أخرج رسالتها إلى إدموند ليظهر أنه يعلم بمؤامرتها ضده.

Edmund regrets his crimes. He gives his sword to the officer so that the Captain will know that Edmund changed his mind. Albany tells the Officer to hurry to stop the death of Lear and Cordelia.

يندم إدموند على جرائمه. يعطي إدموند الضابط سيفه حتي يعرف القبطان أن إدموند غير رآيه. يطلب ألباني من الضابط الاسراع لمنع موت لير وكورديليا.

Lear enters, carrying the dead Cordelia in his arms. Lear is so sad about his daughter's death. When Kent speaks to Lear, he doesn't recognize him. A messenger enters and says that Edmund has also died. Lear also dies.

يدخل لير حاملاً كورديليا الميتة بين ذراعيه. لير حزين للغاية علي وفاة ابنته. عندما تحدث كينت إلى لير، لم يتعرف عليه. يدخل رسول ويقول إن إدموند مات أيضاً. لير يموت أيضاً.

Albany gives Edgar and Kent their power and titles back, inviting them to rule with him. Kent, feeling himself near death, refuses, but Edgar seems to accept.

يعيد ألباني إلى إدجار وكينت سلطتهما وألقابهما، ويدعوهما للحكم معه. كينت، الذي يشعر بأنه على وشك الموت، يرفض، ولكن يبدو أن إدجار يقبل.
